Generally this is a good piece of theological reflection and evaluation of your chosen missional opportunity and clearly satisfies the learning outcomes. Well done.

You do make use of relevant materials, and you do show evidence of some good critical thinking. You could have deepened your critical thinking and evaluation of the chosen opportunity by doing some wider research. For example, you may have been able to find examples of church communities who have used this material to find out about their experiences of using the “Frontline Sundays” material.

You are clearly passionate about this opportunity for your church community, and the ideas presented in “Frontline Sundays” concept do appear to be appropriate for your context. You’ve offered good reasoning and rationale for this.

If I could make one critique in this area it would be that your obvious passion for the idea has at points made the piece sound more like a pitch for the idea than a critically engaged reflective evaluation.

Your language and presentation style are very good throughout.

Your referencing method could be made much clearer. I believe that there is a referencing guide available on the course website. Please do take some time to familiarise yourself with this, and do ask Dawn if you need any further support in getting this small, but important, area of presentation correct.
